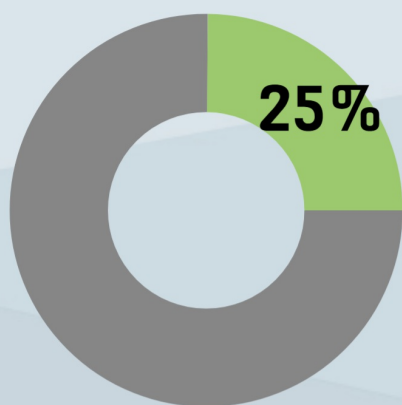

Number of National Program of Cancer Registry Requirements for 2017 that have been met by the WCRS



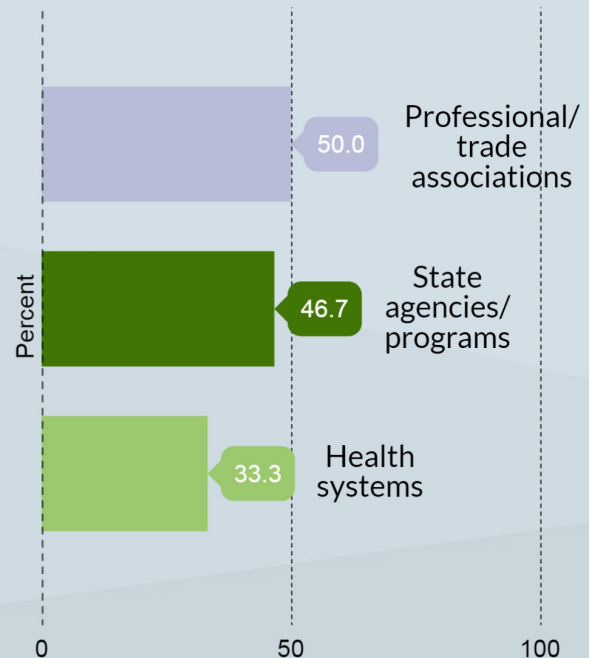
Who is implementing Priority 13?

The majority of members working on Priority 13 come from the following three organization types:

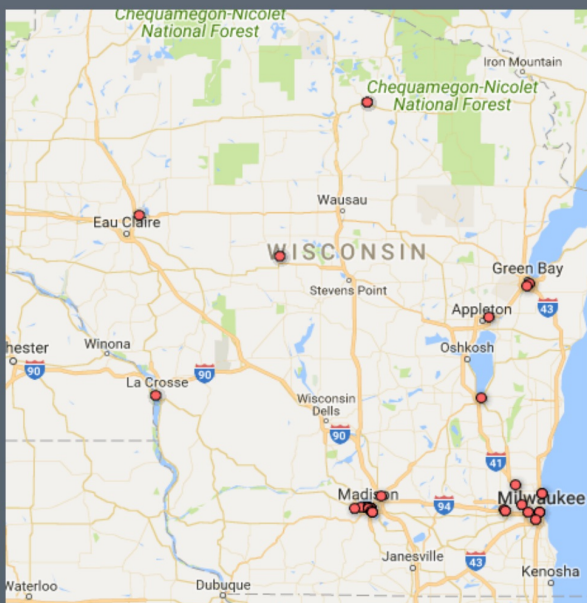
- 1)  12 member reps Health systems
- 2)  11 member reps Universities
- 3)  10 member reps Community-based orgs/non-profits

Members from these three organization types account for 75% of those working on Priority 13

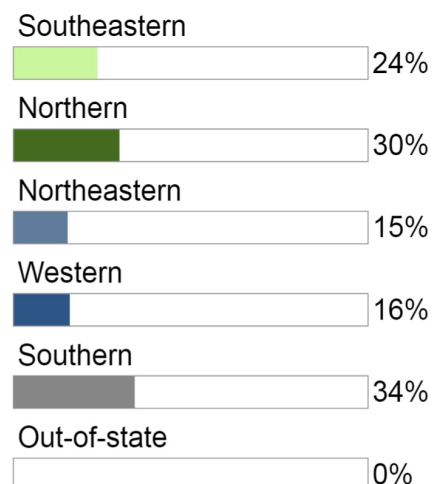
These organization types have the highest percent of members implementing Priority 13
